DayView begins \$2.3M addition

A retirement community in New Carlisle is getting a \$2.3 million addition this year that will bring new assisted living services to the campus.

DayView Retirement Community, which has 50 skilled nursing beds, is working to provide a continuum of care that takes residents from retirement units, where they live without assistance, to nursing home units, which offer full-time nursing care.

The nearly 14,000-square-foot addition, which will attach to the main nursing campus, will add 12 new apartments and be designated for assisted living, which provide residents with ready care but not the full services of nursing care. The addition will also include a new dining room, which will be large enough to serve as a multi-purpose room and gathering area.

The community broke ground on the addition in late December and expects to finish by September. Troy-based Brackett Builders Inc. is handling the work.
